Flawless Finishing Techniques

Learn the tricks for a flawless finish for any knitting projects ... kitchener stitch, mattress stitch, crocheted seam and other seaming options, three needle bind-off, securely weaving in your ends, etc. General knowledge of knitting and purling is required for this class. Cost is \$30.

Materials:

2 - Size 7 needles (I prefer circular but straight needles will do)

Note pad and pencil

Darning needle

Scissors

Removable markers

Homework:

Six - 4" X 4" swatches knit in worsted weight, solid light color with a size 7 needle

Toe Up Socks

This class will teach you to knit toe up socks and includes a skein of self-striping Vesper Sock Yarn. Materials required are size 2 needles ... We use 2 circulars needles with a cable length of 12", 16" or 24" cable. This is an intermediate knitting skills class.

The first session of Sock Class will be about the Turkish Cast On and working through the toe increases and the gusset increases. The second class will be about turning the heel and the stretchy cast off. Cost is \$65.

You will need 2 size #2 circular needles preferably one metal and one bamboo.

Are you knitting? for Beginners

If you have never held a pair of needles in your hands or if you are looking to freshen up your skills, sign up for this class. We will teach you everything you need to get started on a long and satisfying knitting career: casting on, knitting, purling and binding off. This is a 2 session class, about 2 hours per session. Cost is \$45.

Worsted weight, wound yarn and size 7 needles. Class materials purchased at the store are eligible for a 10% discount.

Fair Isle and Steeking

This class will teach you how to knit Fair Isle in the round... steeking... and how to pick up and knit a button band and button holes. Oh yeah, we are going there!! We are going to knit a color work swatch in the round and then we are going to cut it up!!! With scissors!!!! It is going to be awesome. The cost of the class includes the yarn and pattern so just bring your needles and a really sharp pair of scissors. Instructed by Kris Rubert and 2 sessions cost is \$45.00.

Note pad and pencil

Two #5 - #6 16" needles

Scissors

Crochet hook D or E

Stitch markers

Darning needle

Three 1/2" buttons
